

The Tri-County Leadership Initiative (TCLI) is designed to meet the local demand for community leaders. TCLI is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create opportunities for participants to increase their knowledge, skills and confidence; to develop insight; and to become involved leaders in their communities. TCLI offers individuals in Green Lake, Marquette and Waushara Counties and in the Ripon area the opportunity to change their lives and their communities.

TCLI's intense, comprehensive course will:
