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### CAMP BIRD

The camp is located in Marinette County on scenic Sand Lake (30 acres in size). Sandy swimming beach, docks, canoes, rowboats, stream and lake fishing, 10 acres of mowed lawn, huge red pines, oak trees, hiking trails, adventure course, nature center building, recreation building. Camp Bird is the property of Marinette County and is located on county forest land.

There are 42 well kept, log cabin style buildings at the camp. We can accommodate groups as small as 50 people or as large as 230 people. The camp has modern kitchen facilities, a dining center, sinks, showers, flush toilets and electricity.

The camp is currently used by youth organizations, schools, etc.

The Friends of Camp Bird is a non-profit 501(c)3 group organized for the purpose of supporting, assisting and promoting interpretive, scientific, historical, educational, environmental and related visitor services at Camp Bird.

Donations for camp improvements are welcome.
