Steer

(average bid range: \$2.25 - \$3.00/lb.)

1340 pound steer

Sale bid of \$2.75 x 1340 = \$3685

Resale at \$1.50 x 1340 = 2010

Net Cost \$1675

Hog

(average bid range: \$2.00 - \$4.00/lb.)

265 pound hog

Sale bid of \$4.00 x 265 = \$ 1060

Resale at \$1.00 x 265 = 265

Net Cost \$ 795

Lamb

(average bid range: \$3.25 - \$5.00/lb.)

135 pound lamb

Sale bid of \$4.25 x 135 = \$ 575

Resale at \$1.50 x 135 = 200

Net Cost \$ 375

Goat

(average bid range: \$3.00 - \$6.00/lb.)

65 pound kid

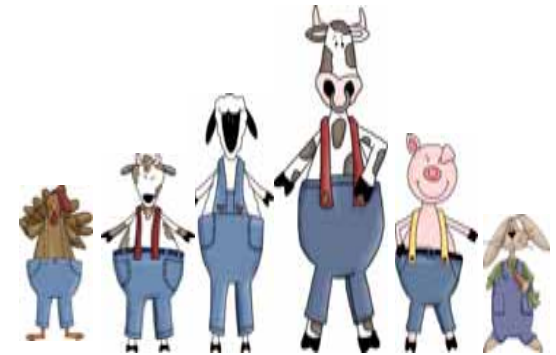
Sale bid of \$4.75 x 65 = \$ 300

CALUMET COUNTY YOUTH MARKET ANIMAL SALE

Objectives

1. To provide junior livestock producers a market for projects graded and sold at the Calumet County Fair.
2. To provide incentives and encourage livestock projects.
3. To recognize members who do quality work in selecting, feeding, and showing their projects.
4. To teach a greater understanding of meat animal evaluation at the packer plant level.

What will be offered

1. **Beef:**
U.S. Prime, Choice, or Select – weight over 1000 pounds
2. **Hogs:**
U.S. Nos. 1, 2, or 3 – weight over 230 pounds
3. **Lambs:**
U.S.D.A. Prime or Choice – weight over 100 pounds
4. **Goats:**
U.S.D.A. Prime or Choice
5. **Rabbits and Poultry:**
After the sale, all poultry and rabbits will be transported to a government inspected processor by the exhibitor. Buyers will be notified when the processed meat is ready for pickup.

Sale provisions

1. Potential bidders must register at sales ring (no obligation).
2. All weights will be stated, and bidding will be based on price per pound for Beef, Hogs, Sheep, and Goats. Rabbits and Poultry will be sold by the pen.
3. All accounts are to be settled with the clerk immediately after sale.
4. Local slaughter plants will slaughter purchased animals if desired. Trucking will be provided.
5. Livestock market buyers will be on hand if purchaser wishes to resell the animal at current market price.
