## 4-H OFFERS CULTURAL ARTS FESTIVAL OPEN TO ALL K-13 STUDENTS

For the first time, Douglas County 4-H's annual Cultural Arts Festival is open to all K-13 students in the county. The festival will be held at Northwestern Elementary School on **Saturday, April 22 from 8:30 – 2:30**. There is no fee to participate and each entry will be judged and receive a premium of \$1, \$2 or \$3 depending on its quality. Art projects done for school assignments are welcome, there is no limit on the number of entries, and the same projects may be entered in the Head of the Lakes Fair (July 11 – 16). Youth can take part in the following categories: Music (individual and group), Solo Acting, Group Drama, Speech, Photography, Arts & Crafts, Literature, Computer Art and Demonstrations. The grade categories for judging are: Cloverbuds (K-2<sup>nd</sup>), Junior (3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>), Intermediate (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>), and Senior (9<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup>).
