

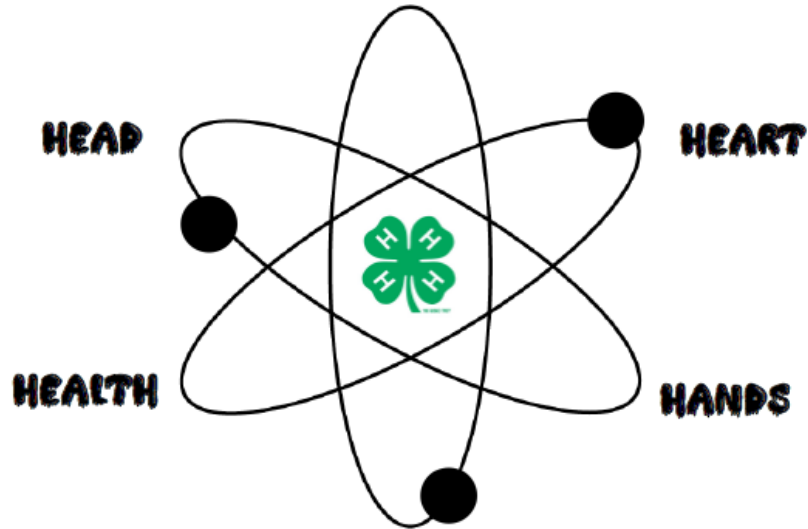
# 4-H JUNIOR CAMP 2017
