Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council requirements are:

- Be a member in “good standing” with a Green Lake County 4-H Club. “Good standing” means you have met **ALL** requirements of your local 4-H club.
- Watch Every Time... Every Ride... video on preventing head injuries. This video needs to be watched once in a 4-H member’s career.
- Earn seven (7) points (4-H members in 13th grade must earn three (3) points) approved by the Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council by the Mandatory Meeting the Thursday prior to the Green Lake County Fair. For a complete breakdown of points please refer to the Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council Quick Guide.

The following may be submitted to the UW-Extension Office or brought to a 4-H Horse Council meeting:

- Submit a “copy” of the Coggins Form for each horse participating in any Green Lake county 4-H Horse Council sponsored clinic or show to the Green Lake County UW-Extension Office by May 1.
- Submit dues of \$30 or participate in an official Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council Fundraiser (Dunk Tank). Due by the July Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council meeting.
- Complete and submit a Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council Sponsorship Form. Due by the July Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council meeting.
- Complete and submit the Green Lake County 4-H Horse Project Member Agreement (this form). Due by the July Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council meeting.
- Complete and submit a Green Lake County 4-H Horse Council Information Card by the Mandatory Meeting the Thursday prior to the Green Lake County Fair.

Green Lake County Fair Horse Show requirements are:

- Complete and submit (on-line) a Green Lake County Fair Exhibitor Entry Form
- Complete and submit a Green Lake County Fair Horse Identification Form for the horse being exhibited by May 1st to the Green Lake County UW-Extension Office.
- Submit a “copy” of the Coggins Form for the Horse being exhibited by May 1st to the Green Lake County UW-Extension Office.
- Attend the Green Lake County Fair Horse Show Mandatory meeting on the Thursday prior to the Green Lake County Fair.
- Present the “original” Coggins Form for the horse being exhibited to the Horse Show Superintendents at the Green Lake County Horse Show.
