- 24-hour program designed to teach tractor and general farm safety
- Includes both classroom and hands-on driving instruction, culminating in a final written and driving exam
- Open to youth under the age of **16** and over the age of **12**
- Meets the requirements of Wisconsin Act 455, which requires youth under the age of 16 to hold a certificate of training in order to operate a tractor on a public road
- Meets the child labor requirements under the Fair Labor Standards Act, pertaining to the employment of youth ages 14-15 on farms not operated by their parents or guardians
