### **Junior, Grades 6-8: (150 word limit)**

Everyone has challenges in life. Describe a challenge in your life and relate how any 4-H experiences you have had may help you deal with this challenge.

### **Senior, Grades 9-13: (200-250 words)**

Write about one of your most significant 4-H activities. How has this helped you grow and develop as a person?
