Master Gardener Level 1 Training

Are you thinking about becoming a volunteer for UW-Extension as a Master Gardener?

Anyone interested in taking the Master Gardener Level 1 training course for Racine and Kenosha Counties will need to attend the mandatory orientation session scheduled for Monday, July 17th from 6:00 to 7:30 pm at the Northside Library, 1500 27th Ave. in Kenosha.

At this session, you will learn about the UW-Extension Master Gardener volunteer program and the requirements to become a Master Gardener volunteer.

In order to become a UW-Extension volunteer, a person will need to agree to a criminal background check, take Mandatory Reporter Training, and sign a volunteer behavior agreement. There is a fee of \$150 for the course. The course will run for 12 weeks, meeting once per week for a 3 hour session.

The course will be taught as flipped instruction, meaning the participants taking the course will need to have access to a computer to view the lecture part of the training. The training will be offered on Wednesday's from September 6 through November 22.
