

BARBARA HARTJES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A \$1,000 scholarship is available

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled (or a high school senior intending to enroll) as a full-time student in a Bachelor's Program at any college or university, or a two-year Associate Degree Program at any technical college. The applicant must plan to pursue further education within the next school year.
2. Scholarship is open to all careers of residents of Kewaunee County.
3. Applications should be completed and postmarked on or before April 1, 2017 to: **Scholarship Committee, Jan Tess, 1409 Second Street, Kewaunee, WI 54216. Applications postmarked after this date will be disqualified.**
4. A high school grade transcript and a college grade transcript, if presently enrolled in a college, must be submitted with the application form.
5. Criteria used in the screening process will be the following: "Leadership Development", "Essay", "Grade Transcript(s)", word processed (not handwritten), neatness, grammar, completeness, punctuation and clarity. If any item (application parts 1-3, transcript) is missing, the application will be disqualified.
6. Application must be accompanied by an essay (maximum 200 words) explaining **"How your acquired experiences have shaped your career goals for the education you are seeking."**
7. By February 1, the scholarship recipient must furnish proof of completion of first semester of the year receiving the scholarship and proof of enrollment for the second semester to Kay Ratajczak, 1416 Kilbourn Street, Kewaunee WI 54216. Payment will then be made by the scholarship chair.
8. If selected for the scholarship, the signatures on the background information sheet grant permission to the Wisconsin Association for Home & Community Education (WAHCE) to use my image or comments (including audio, moving image, or photograph) in WAHCE reports, articles, and publications designed for educational, informational, and promotional purposes.
9. This will be presented at both the HCE Spring Banquet and High School Awards Night.
