## ***Time to Re-Enroll!***

4HOnline (<http://wi.4honline.com>) is now ready to accept new and re-enrollments for the 2016-2017 enrollment year. I have attached a set of instructions on how to complete the re-enrollment process.

Youth in 12th grade last year and those youth older than 17 years have some changes. The 13th year members need to select their grade status (Post High School or Not in School). The 18 years+ youth need to decide if they are going to enroll as a Youth or switch to Adult Volunteer. If you are switching to Adult Volunteer, you will need to attend Volunteer Orientation. (Watch for information on upcoming Volunteer Orientations.)

I have attached instructions for re-enrollment and for new enrollments in 4HOnline, which can be shared with new members.

### ***Tractor and Farm Safety Camp***

Does your son or daughter work on a farm during the summer? Do you hire youth to work for you during the year? Do these young people have adequate safety training? Accidents cause more deaths to individuals between the ages of 15 and 24 than all other causes combined. To help reduce accidents, a Tractor & Farm Safety Camp is being coordinated by UW-Extension Manitowoc County.

The next camp is scheduled for November 11-13, 2016. Camp TaPaWingo is located at 915 West TaPaWingo Road, Mishicot, Wisconsin. Cost for the camp is \$195 and includes lodging, meals, training materials, and 24 hours of instruction.

The camp will focus on the safety aspects of operating farm equipment and daily farm tasks. To complete the course, youth must attend all sessions and pass a written and a driving exam. Certificates will be issued by the Manitowoc County UW-Extension office following successful completion of

### ***Manitowoc County 4-H Dairy Judging Team Excels at National Contest***

Only two points separated the top two teams at the National 4-H Dairy Cattle Judging Contest held October 3rd in conjunction with World Dairy Expo in Madison.

The Wisconsin team, consisting of four Manitowoc County youth, placed second in the national contest. Minnesota won the event.

In addition to placing second overall, the Wisconsin team consisting of Vanessa Roberts, Jake Siemers, Brooke Roberts, and Jared Zutz placed first in oral reasons. Twenty six teams competed in the national contest.

Overall, Brooke Roberts was 3rd with 710 points and Vanessa Roberts was 9th with 701 points. Vanessa Roberts also placed second overall in reasons with 235 points, while Brooke Roberts placed 5th in reasons with 231 points.
