

**4-H Senior Youth Council and Pepin County 4-H Clubs  
2017 Silent Auction  
Pepin County Fair**

**Purpose:** To raise funds to assist with educational programs for the 4-H youth in the Pepin County 4-H Program.

**What?** A basket, box, or bag filled with goodies that anyone can bid on.

**When and Where?** Bidding will start Friday morning of the fair, 10:00 am and end on Sunday, 1:00 pm of the Pepin County Fair.

**Who gets the money?** Profits will be split 20/80 with the clubs, so if your club's basket(s) is sold for \$44.00---then \$35.20 goes to the 4-H club and \$8.80 goes to the Pepin County Senior Youth Council.

**What is the 4-H Club's Responsibility?**

1. Put together a basket(s) of goodies.
2. Each club will provide their own basket(s).
3. Size of basket(s) will be the decision of the club.
4. Items in the basket is the club's responsibility (hopefully donated)
  - ~gift certificate to a store, restaurant (hopefully donated)
  - ~non perishable items donated by local stores
  - ~a service provided by a 4-H family for the buyer of the basket, such as a dozen cookies or pet sitting or a dinner made for the buyer by a 4-H family (with an agreeable date for both parties)
  - ~a theme basket (such everything in the basket is green or a basket filled with gardening supplies or filled with 'Bob the Builder' items)
  - ~be creative
5. Please put a \$ value on items so it can be announced or published on the bidding sheet as part of the minimum bid.
6. Fill out the attached sheet listing the items and value per item per basket.
7. Bring your basket(s) filled and ready, and completed listing sheet to the fair on Friday morning. Place on display at the fair.
8. Please adhere to a limit of 3 baskets per club.
9. Be sure to fill out the top of the Bidding Sheet too.
