Indianhead Sheep Breeders plan the 2017 Shepherds' Clinic for February 4th Clinic will be held in

the Conference Center of the Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College, 1900 College Drive, Rice Lake, WI 54868. This annual workshop continues to be one of the largest educational events of the winter for sheep producers and 4-H & FFA youth in the upper Midwest. The 2017 Shepherds' Clinic has been expanded to include goats as well as sheep. The program will focus on Profitability and Sustainability, Genetics and Reproduction, and Flock Health plus special breakout sessions for youth enrolled in 4-H and FFA livestock projects. To register online, visit <http://barron.uwex.edu/>. Click "2017 Shepherds' Clinic and Tradeshow" to register. The registration fee to attend the Shepherds' Clinic is \$45 per person for ISBA members and \$50 per person for non-members. Members of the Wisconsin Sheep Breeders Assn. receive a \$5 discount off their registration fee. 4-H and FFA members pay only \$15 per person for the Shepherds' Clinic. The registration fee covers the program costs, refreshments and the noon meal. The registration deadline is February 1, 2017. Late registrations cost an additional \$10 for adults and \$5 for youth.
