



WASHINGTON COUNTY CLOVERBUD GUIDELINES



1. Cloverbud members must be 5 years old and in kindergarten – 2nd grades as of October 1, to join a 4-H club.
2. Cloverbuds and Explorers are encouraged to have separate project meetings. However, if clubs prefer to have meetings together, they should avoid duplication from year to year.
3. Educational materials to use with Cloverbud members will be available at the UW-Extension Office.
4. Cloverbud members should be allowed to enter the following county contests: Demonstration, Music & Drama, Poster, and Speaking. They will receive participation ribbons for each contest.
5. Each club should decide if they want their Cloverbud members to pay club dues. They do need to pay the county dues.
6. Project leaders are encouraged to have five meetings a year.
7. The Cloverbuds are encouraged to attend meetings held by the project leaders. They can exhibit at County Fair. Certificates of completion can be awarded to them.
8. Cloverbud members can complete a record book. It would be a special Cloverbud record book consisting of a self decorated pronged folder, Cloverbud Project Sheet and Cloverbud Story Sheet. This is not required.
9. Cloverbuds can exhibit anything but animals.
