

4-H - Being a Good Citizen

Time needed: 10-15 minutes.

Age: any age

Materials:

Citizen sheet (attached)

Writing utensil

What to do:

1. Print off/copy Citizen sheets for every youth in your club.
2. Have them put their name in the box that says "Your Name".
3. Have the youth in your club fill out all the blanks using the words at the top of the page. Each word is used only one time.
4. When everyone is complete (or after a few minutes) have the club split into groups of 5-10 youth depending on the size of your club.
5. Have the members share their responses with their group.
6. Have each group pick one number/ answer and explain to the entire club on what it means to them.
7. Ask each group if they have an example of the answer, for example for "Help take care of the environment" – Perhaps they clean up the park or highway.
8. A master sheet exists of the answers.
