

# Citizenship Bingo

Time needed: 10-15 minutes.

Age: any age

Materials:

- Bingo sheet (attached)
- Writing utensil

What to do:

1. Print off/copy bingo sheets for every youth in your club.
2. Have them put their name in the box that says "Your Name".
3. Have the youth in your club move around putting their name/initials in the box that they have done.
4. When all of the members have bingo (if have a large club) or most of them (if have a smaller club) have a full BINGO card, they can sit down.
5. Finish by asking reflection questions.

2. How do you become a good citizen?
3. Do you think you can become a better citizen? How?
