

## Where In The World Can 4-H Take You?

**Description:** A matching board of places and trips you can attend through 4-H.

**Purpose:** To get a sense of where you can travel to through 4-H, and learn about the many opportunities available through Washington County and Wisconsin 4-H.

**Time:** No more than 15 minutes

**Age/Grade:** 3rd grade and up

**Suggestions:** if you have younger youth, partner them with older youth. For larger groups split them in two and have them take turns matching.

**Materials:** Where In The World Will 4-H Take You matching board (available for check out at the UW-Extension Office)

### What to do:

1. Check out the matching board from the office and review the sheet of correct answers. Make sure all the names of camps and trips are scrambled up and not already in place.
2. Set up board in front of group. Talk about the purpose of the game.
3. Ask for volunteers to come up make one match each. After the group has matched them all together, check for the correct answers and tell them how they did.
4. Give the group time to look at the board of places and read the sentences about them.
5. For a bonus, have the youth find Chris Clover in each picture! Each Chris is wearing a 4-H shirt!
6. Ask review questions and clean up.

### Review Questions:

1. Are there any trips you didn't know about?
2. Are there any trips you're interested in attending?
3. Was there anything really hard about this activity?

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
