## **WINNEBAGO COUNTY TACK SALE 2016 Vendor Information & Reservation Request**

The Winnebago County 4-H Tack Sale will be Saturday March 5th 2016 in the Exposition Building at the Sunnyview Expo Center & Fairgrounds. (500 East County Road Y, Oshkosh WI 54901.) Hours for the event are 9am to 2pm. Food will be available to purchase and general admission will be \$1.00 for attendees. Doors will open at 7am for vendor set-up. Vendor spaces are 8' x 10' and are available for \$20 each. Spaces include chairs and tables at no extra charge. In-door trailer spaces are \$75 each and must be approved by the Tack Sale Chairperson due to space limitations.

Once a completed reservation request form (page 2), payment, and signed vendor agreement has been received, you will receive confirmation via email that your request has been received. At the time of set-up, you will be provided with a copy of the completed vendor agreement with all signatures. 4-H volunteers will be available to assist you with doors and transporting merchandise to/from your space.

To insure fairness in assigning vendor space we will assign space on a first come first serve basis. A COMPLETED RESERVATION REQUEST AND A \$20 RESERVATION FEE PER SPACE OR \$75 RESERVATION FEE PER TRAILER ALONG WITH THE SIGNED VENDOR AGREEMENT MUST BE RECEIVED TO BE ASSIGNED SPACE(S).

A donated item for the silent auction would be greatly appreciated. All items will be identified with the Donor's name and the Donor's name will be announced with the awarding of the item to the successful bidder.
