



## 2017 Winnebago County Dairy Futurity

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual All-Breeds Futurity

Hosted by: Winnebago County 4-H Dairy Project

**When:** Friday, August 4, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. Winnebago County Fair Grounds, Covered Arena

**Who:** Open to all Jr. and Open exhibitors from Winnebago, Waushara, Waupaca and Green Lake Counties! All animals must have a valid registration paper with their respective breed association.

**Purpose:** The Futurity will celebrate the high caliber dairy genetics and producing herds of Winnebago, Green Lake, Waushara and Waupaca County farm families. Animals are “nominated” by their owners as young calves in the hope of developing into star-quality cows. The event is designed to be both entertaining and educational for the public and those interested or invested in the dairy industry.

**Procedures:** An animal is nominated by its owner and all nominations are the responsibility of the owner. Animals only participating in the futurity must arrive on grounds and check in between 7-10 p.m. on Thursday, August 3, or 5-7 a.m. on Friday August 4. All futurity animals are released after the show and must be off the grounds by 7 a.m. Saturday following the show.

Farms may have a leadsperson on the halter that does not have ownership of the nominated animal.

Registration papers and health papers, dated within 10 days of the show, are required to be with the animal at time of check-in. Animals without papers will not be allowed off the trailer until appropriate papers are presented to management.

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top class winners, Best Dressed male and Best dressed female of each class and Best Udder. Payout of Purse will be determined based on number of animals exhibited.

**Refunds:** When nomination fees are paid they are committed to the Futurity purse and refunds will not be made, whether or not the animal is shown or its eligibility is discontinued by the owner.

**Dress Code:** Exhibitors must be in formal dress to show in the Futurity. Minimum requirements for men include: shirt, tie and dress pants; for women: at least a knee-length dress, business suit or equivalent. Exhibitors must wear closed toed shoes. Above the knee skirts, dragging trains and open toed shoes are strictly prohibited. Exhibitors not meeting the minimum dress code requirement will be denied entry into the Showring.

**Release of Liability:** Every precaution will be taken to properly protect animals and exhibits in this show. The management and the Winnebago County Fair Association, however, will not be liable for the safety of animals, exhibits, exhibitors or their employees, or for losses sustained because of robbery, damage by fire, accident or any other cause.
