We are continuing to offer instruction in Archery, Rifle and Hunting and Ecology at the County level. For all other disciplines, you will need your parents to help you. Also, watch the News & Views for changes.

We are again offering 2 sessions of Archery. Please call or email us **in advance** to let us know which session you wish to attend. If you are in both Rifle and Archery program, you must attend the early Archery session. All youth are asked to attend the Hunting and Ecology session in addition to their scheduled session(s).

Please make sure you and your equipment are ready at the start time. We would like to have **all archery equipment checked in prior to the session start time.** Make sure your bow is in a case. Please make sure you are enrolled in any sessions you wish to attend.

We will again have a \$10 project fee due at the first class. This is to help pay for the equipment and building rental. The fee is per student, not per class. Some of the field trips may require a fee payable at the location.

In order to participate in the .22 rifle class, you must be 12 years of age and have a copy of your DNR Hunter Education certificate.

Archery members: We will be trying to set up a 3-D shoot at Critter's Wolf River Sports in March or April. At this point, we don't know if a fee will be charged. It is not included in the project fee. There may be additional sessions set up throughout the year. Details will be given at our meetings and in the News & Views. We will let you know the dates when they are scheduled. **You must have attended one of the classes in January, February or March to attend these additional shoots.**

For the Archery program, you are encouraged to bring your own equipment. This will help you become comfortable with your bow. If you don't have a bow, don't worry. We have county equipment available for you. We are still looking for donations of equipment or money. Please see Dave or Jeff for details.

Rifle members: The rifle programs will be **using our county 4-H rifle equipment**. Please **DO NOT** bring your own gun. We will need your DNR Hunter's Education number to keep on file if you participate in the .22 rifle portion. We hope to have more activities this year. Please watch the News & Views for more information.

All members: There are many invitational shoots throughout the state. Many have deadlines in March and April. Many of them also require hands on training each year with instructor or coordinator signatures, which you complete by attending our shoots. The enrollment forms are available on the State 4-H Shooting Sports web site: <http://www.uwex.edu/ces/4h/onlinpro/shooting/index.cfm>. Please try to attend if possible.

Remember, a parent or guardian needs to attend all of the meetings with you.

We are including in the packet a Medical Care and Treatment form, Waiver/Code of conduct form, Information form, and T-shirts and Sweatshirts form. **Please have this information completed ahead of time to hand in at our first meeting. You need these filled out to participate in the sessions.** Even if you attended last year, you will need to update this information. Thank you for your cooperation.

*Back by popular demand is the Wild Game Feed on March 4th. If you or someone you know has access to any game which can be donated, please contact Jo Custer – (920) 948-8935. We don't need you to prepare it, just donate it. We will take care of the rest.

To help us set up the program to meet your needs, we need to know some information about you. We have a current list of youth enrolled in the project. If you are going to sign up for archery or rifle, please contact us before attending a session. Also, please tell us if you plan to use your own equipment and if you have graduated from a DNR Hunter Education program. Winnebago County UW-Extension Youth Expectations

Winnebago County UW-Extension has established the following Youth Expectations for youth participating in Winnebago County UW-Extension sponsored programs and representing UW-Extension programs while participating in outside events. Questions about the Youth Expectations should be directed to the Winnebago County Extension Office.

Youth who participate in Winnebago County UW-Extension Events will:

- Behave in ways respectful of others including manners and language to other participants, adult leadership, general public, etc.
- Respect public and personal property. This includes financial liability for any damages to public and/or private property beyond reasonable use.
- Follow and obey all local, state, and federal laws including:
 - Not consuming or possessing any alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco products, or unsafe use of over the counter drugs or prescription medication.
 - Only using the medications as prescribed by a physician.
- Exhibit good sportsmanship.
- Serve as a positive role model.
- Follow all UW-Extension and U.S. D.A. rules, polices, and guidelines.
- Treat animals in a humane manner and provide appropriate animal care and management.

If a youth is found in violation of the Youth Expectations, complete the “Winnebago County Care to Share Form”. In order to ensure the privacy of the youth and consistency for all involved, the youth will meet with the appropriate UW-Extension staff member to address the issue.

Suspension & Reinstatement of Membership:

Violation of the Youth Expectations may result in probation, suspension, or termination of membership in all Winnebago County UW-Extension programs. Suspended members may apply for reinstatement after one year.

Prior to re-instatement of membership, the individual must:

- Present a signed statement of apology to the Winnebago County UW-Extension Office.
- Reimburse the Winnebago County UW-Extension office/program for monies received towards awards, trips, or other activities if the violation occurs before or during the event.

A second infraction will result in permanent dismissal from all Winnebago County UW-Extension programs.
