Position Title: 4-H Dipper Manager(s)



Background:

- The 4-H Dipper is the food stand that 4-H operates during the Winnebago County Fair, Wednesday-Sunday. 4-H members, leaders, and parents work together to prepare, run, and clean the 4-H Dipper. The 4-H Dipper provides 30% of the income for the Winnebago County 4-H Leaders' Association which directly off sets the cost of 4-H events and activities to keep 4-H affordable.

Term of Responsibility/Time Commitment:

- 10-20 hours prior to fair for supervising/coordinating the 4-H Dipper Team
- 20 hours throughout the fair to ensure the smooth running of the 4-H Dipper
- 5-10 hours post fair for clean-up and review

Responsibilities:

- Oversees the smooth running of the 4-H Dipper
- Oversees the smooth running of the 4-H Dipper Team
- Be familiar with the responsibilities of all 4-H Dipper Team members
- Recruit/confirm members for the 4-H Dipper Team – in or outside of the 4-H program
- Works with the 4-H Youth Development staff to follow proper licensing, financial, purchasing, food policies, etc.

Qualifications:

- Written and oral communication skills
- Ability to negotiate
- Ability to lead a team
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to keep records

- Reports to the 4-H Youth Development Staff
- Works with the Winnebago County 4-H Leaders Association

Training Required:

- Orientation on responsibilities, approximately 30-60 minutes
