Committed staff/volunteers to be play assistants (all materials/training provided) for your event

Space for as many (or as few) block stations as you choose (3-11)

1 ½ - 2 hours set aside for your event (which can be in conjunction with another event)

Assistance with finding volunteers, and we will access our pool of trained volunteers

A staff member at your event to oversee the fun and facilitate the event

Original materials for you to reproduce and provide to your participants (or we can work out a small fee for the booklets)
